

Grade Expectation Sheet – **LIVING ENVIRONMENT ADVANCED**

Classroom Rules and Procedures for Science Students

1. Students should be prepared for class everyday with a pen & pencil, notebook (binder with 3 dividers), folder & a purchased workbook.
2. Students are expected to arrive on time for class. Students not adhering to these guidelines will be marked late. Any student that is late three times will receive a cut slip and a phone call home.
3. Students must request makeup work the first day they return to school from an absence. The teacher shall set the time for the makeup work at the time of the students' request. **NO LATE ASSIGNMENTS WILL BE ACCEPTED** after the due date.
4. It is the responsibility of the student to save all worksheets, tests and homework in their notebooks. Notebook checks may be counted as a quiz throughout the year.
5. Students are expected to cooperate with all class and school rules. Cell phones, Ipods, , other electronic devices, and hats will be confiscated. Students and their parents are advised to check the student handbook for appropriate dress code.
6. Homework will be assigned at least 4 times a week. HW may include completion of laboratory assignments, worksheets, projects, text assignments, studying, and vocabulary. If a student is absent it is their responsibility to retrieve the assignments. Homework is designed to both reinforce and introduce material.
7. The Lab component of the class must be completed according to NYS policy. Failure to complete the number of lab hours required will result in not being able to take the Regents Exam.
8. Extra help hours will be held before, during and after school by appointment.
9. Grading policy: Your grade is based on your performance in class and outside of class.
 - a. Tests 65 %
 - b. Quizzes 10%
 - c. Homework 5%
 - d. Labs 15%
 - e. Projects 5%
10. There is a school board policy for students in advanced classes. An advanced student must continue to meet the following criteria.
 1. Consistent classroom achievement at or above the 85th percentile.
 2. Achievement test scores/ projects in the 90th percentile or better.
 3. Evidence that the student possesses a superior degree of interest, aptitude and motivation for this topic area.
 4. Teacher recommendation in the subject area.
